Approval of Agenda: Motion by Petra Streiff, second by Barb Anderson to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes of the 11/15/17 Meeting: Motion by Barb Anderson, second by Petra Streiff to approve the 11/15/17 minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Presentation/Discussion/Recommendation: Ethan Gray, a New Glarus School District student, appeared before the Committee to discuss a potential Eagle Scout project at Hoesly Pond. He indicated that he would like to install a “Welcome to Hoesly Pond” sign with landscaping, and has worked with Dove Design to get a preliminary design and cost estimate of \$400.00. Greg Thoenke asked about the potential of locating the sign between Hoesly Pond and Hwy 69 for better visibility. The Committee funding arrangements with potential contribution from the FFA Alumni group and the Village. The Committee asked Mr. Gray to request a quote from Dove Design for a double-signed sign. The Committee was in agreement that it was a good project, and design and location needed to be decided as next steps.

Park and Recreation Committee Meeting Notes for January 10, 2018

General Discussion/Presentation: Triathlon Committee 2017 Report: A representative from the Triathlon Committee will attend the meeting to provide the Committee with an update on the 2017 Triathlon event and plans for the 2018 event.

General Discussion/Recommendation: 2018 Pool and Park & Recreation Fees: Staff recommends keeping the pool and park fees the same as 2017. A copy of draft Resolution 18-01, which incorporates the proposed 2018 fees is attached.

Update: Potential Eagle Scout Project at Hoesly Pond: New Glarus High School Student and Eagle Scout Candidate Ethan Gray received an updated quote for a two sided sign from Dove Designs. It would be \$400 for the 1st face, and \$355 for the second face. He is waiting to hear back from the FFA Alumni on a potential contribution. Staff will continue to work with Mr. Gray to analyze potential sign location options at Hoesly Pond.

AND DOES FURTHER RESOLVE that all fees shall be paid to the New Glarus Village Treasurer prior to the start of the program.

AND DOES FURTHER RESOLVE that adult shall be defined as an individual having graduated from High School, having completed the equivalent of K-12 education, or 18 years of age;

That family shall be defined as no more than two adults living together and their natural, adopted or foster children whether living with parent or not. If families have a summer daycare provider, they may add that person to their family pass for an additional \$15;

That all season pass fees shall be paid to the New Glarus Village Treasurer before beginning swimming lessons and/or prior to the use of the pool;

Any cancellation made after the registration deadline is subject to a \$5.00 surcharge. No refunds will be given after the first session or practice has taken place, other than in the case of a severe illness or injury that prevents participation. Full refunds will be given for all programs cancelled by the Village. Refunds will be made by check and mailed to the address provided on the registration. Group discounts information can be obtained at the Village Offices.
