Green County Referendum

On January 10, 2010, in *Citizens United v. Federal Elections Commission*, the United States Supreme Court held that political spending is a form of protected speech under the First Amendment and the government may not keep corporations or unions from spending money to support or denounce individual candidates in elections. While corporations or unions may not give money directly to campaigns, they may seek to persuade the voting public through other means, including advertisements. Shall Green County support passage of an amendment to the United States Constitution stating the following:

1. Only human beings — not corporations, unions, nonprofits or other legal entities — are endowed with constitutional rights, and
2. Money is not speech, and therefore regulating political contributions and spending is not equivalent to limiting political speech.
