Code of Conduct for Parents

To prevent any misunderstanding or misinterpretations when problems occur during the baseball season, the Village of New Glarus has instituted the following Code of Conduct for parents.

As a parent of a player, I agree to:

1. Respect the managers and their coaching staff. Managers and coaches are volunteers who donate their time and expertise to the youth baseball/softball program. My appreciation of their efforts is paramount to ensuring an ample supply of managers and coaches in the program. I will take practices and games seriously by making sure that my child(ren) are available and on time as scheduled. I will collect my child(ren) in a timely manner when practices and games are finished.
2. Respect all players. All players are contributors to a team and should be positively encouraged by all parents. I will not engage in insults or criticisms of players. Such behavior does not promote team spirit but breaks apart a team and will not be tolerated.
3. Follow proper channels to resolve any dispute with the youth baseball/softball program. The Park and Recreation Director is willing to assist any parent that has a problem with any of its programs. If I have an issue or problem, I understand that I should follow the communication/conflict resolution process set by the Village of New Glarus.
4. Display good sportsmanship at all times. The children are learning to become team players and work toward a common goal. I will always be non-judgmental and my support for their attempts and their outcomes.
5. Be a contributor to the youth baseball/softball program. I will volunteer in some aspect of the program (ie: help with practices, equipment, fundraising).
6. Appreciate that the Village of New Glarus is striving to provide the best baseball/softball program for my children. The programs of the Summer Recreation Department are intended to be a fun learning experience for all players. I will relax and enjoy the youth baseball/softball experience.
