Brush and Yard Waste Disposal

Brush Curbside Pick-Up

The Village of New Glarus provides curbside pickup of brush from April through October. Brush includes clean, woody, vegetative material no greater than six inches in diameter. Pick-up occurs during the first week of the month. Brush should be left on the terrace and should **NOT** be placed in the street or curb/gutter area.

If brush is not placed correctly, it may not be picked up. Brush Collection requirements are as follows:

- Brush must be stacked neatly at the curb, piled no more than 4 feet high, with cut ends facing the curb. Brush placed in an unkempt manner will not be picked up.
- Leave branches in long segments, as long as 1 person can handle. Do not cut into small segments.
- Brush should not be piled in a manner that affects motorist visibility, and should also be kept away from trees, signs, parked cars, mailboxes, fire hydrants, and utility poles.
- Do not put brush in bags, boxes, or trash containers - it will not be picked up. Keep brush in back of curb.
- Materials cannot be greater than 6 inches in diameter. Materials less than 1 inch in diameter is considered compost and will not be picked up.
- The Village will not collect brush cut or trimmed by contractors. Contractors hired by property owners are responsible for removing the material. Collections are for brush and tree trimmings from a typical residential clean-up, not entire tree removals.
- Do not mix yard waste (grass clippings, yard debris, garden debris in with your brush pile, neither will be collected.
- Keep brush free of wire, tape, or inorganic materials. The use of string or twine is acceptable.
- Brush does **NOT** include Stumps, roots, shrubs with intact root bulbs, logs, materials resulting from tree removal, or materials trimmed/removed by a contractor.

Brush Drop Off

During the months of November through March, brush must be dropped off at the Public Works Drop-Off area accessible from Second Street. No Compost or yard waste is allowed at this site. This area is for residents only. Contractors may not use this site.

Yard Waste Drop Off

Yard waste will not be picked up curbside and should not be placed in the curb line for storage

If you have yard waste (grass clippings, garden debris, yard debris) it must be disposed of at the yard waste bunker at 93 1st Street. The bunker is available from April through November. Please remember to empty your bag into the bunker, do not place bags into the bunker. **YARD WASTE ONLY** should be placed in this bunker. This area is for residents only. Contractors may not use this site.
