GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage pickup will be every *Monday*. Each household in New Glarus is required to have an automated garbage cart. Your garbage cart will be delivered by *Pellitteri Waste System* in December. To report problems with your cart please contact *Pellitteri Waste System* for assistance. For detailed information regarding placement of the cart please refer to the brochure provided with cart. The garbage and recycling carts should be placed together, with two (2) feet between them.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Recycling pickup will be every *other* week on Monday (see schedule included). *Pellitteri Waste Systems* will utilize your existing recycling cart for pick-up. If you need a new cart, or to report problems with your existing cart please contact *Pellitteri Waste System* for assistance. The lid on the cart illustrates correct placement of the cart at your curb.

COLLECTION TIMES

Items for collection shall be at the curb or near the street edge for collection by **7:00 a.m. on day of pickup [Monday] (including clean-up day)**.

Schedule Changes will be posted on the Village website: www.newglarusvillage.com and published in the Post Messenger Recorder as time permits. Contact *Pellitteri Waste System* to get on email blasts that include inclement weather delays.

RECYCLING

With single-stream recycling you do not have to sort your recyclables. **All recycling must be in the cart, with lid closed.** Recyclable materials should be clean and kept dry. Any item left in the cart has been rejected and will have a ticket in the cart explaining why it was rejected. The following recyclable materials go in the carts:

Paper:

- Cardboard, catalogs, magazines & phone books, cereal and cracker boxes, computer/office paper, envelopes, holiday gift wrap (no foils), newspapers, paper egg cartons, paper grocery bags, paper milk and juice cartons, pizza boxes (no food or grease), shredded paper (place in clear plastic bag and tie shut)

Plastic:

- All plastic bottles (no motor oils or gasoline), plastic containers #1-7 (including #1 deli), plastic bags (grocery, newspaper, dry cleaning, etc. – no black or brown bags) place clean, dry bags into a clear bag and tie shut so bags are the size of a basketball

Metal & Glass:

- Tin and steel cans, aerosol cans (empty), aluminum cans and pie plates, glass bottles and jars (clear, blue, brown or green translucent glass), metal pots and pans, small metal appliances (toasters, blenders, etc.-nothing larger than a basketball) small metal plumbing fixtures (faucets, valves, pipes 2"-12" long)

SPRING CLEAN-UP

Spring Clean-Up Day will be held on **Monday, June 4, 2018**. Accepted items include: furniture, household trash, dry carpet (rolled and tied for one-person to handle), swing sets (dismantled), bagged box springs and mattresses, bed frames, gas grills (no tanks), charcoal grills, small lawn mowers or snowblowers (gas and oil must be removed). **NOT accepted:** e-waste including televisions and computer monitors, yard waste, building materials, tires, pianos, lead acid batteries, 55-gallon drums, household pesticides, concrete or dirt, oil tanks and filters, vehicle engine blocks, paints and thinners, and large appliances.

Large appliances (i.e. stoves, refrigerators, microwaves, etc.) In order to have a large appliance picked up **with the Spring Clean-up on Monday, June 4, 2018**, please contact the Village Clerk's Office at 527-3677 as those **will require the purchase of an appliance sticker**. To dispose of large appliances at any other time of the year, please contact *Pellitteri Waste System* directly.

E-WASTE

Wisconsin's electronics recycling law *prohibits the disposal* of various electronic devices such as: computers, computer monitors, printers, TVs, VCRs, DVD players and phones with video displays. Green County Landfill and/or Madison Area Rehabilitation Centers (608-273-3630) will accept electronic devices at a fee. BRUSH – YARDWASTE – LEAVES

Brush and branches for curbside pickup should be placed curbside by the *first day of each month from April through October for pickup within the 1st week of that month by the Village*. Brush can also be dropped off at the brush pile on 2nd Street (north of 1st Avenue)

Yard Waste must be composted or dropped off in the compost bunker located at the Village Garage at 93 – 1st Street anytime during the months of April-November. Only yard waste should be placed in the bunker.

Leaf Pickup: Leaves will only be picked up with the Leaf Vacuum. The Village will perform this service as weather permits during October/November. Leaves need to be raked into the gutter for this service.

Please Note: Bagged leaves, compost, and yard waste will not be picked up curbside.

BULK WASTE ITEMS

Bulk waste items can be disposed of at any time by calling *Pellitteri Waste System* at (800) 400-4285 and arranging the pickup or hauling directly to the Green County Landfill. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Batteries Car batteries can be dropped off during normal business hours at: Alpine Auto Electric, New Glarus Motors and Stampfli Auto. Batteries shouldn't be cracked or leaking.

Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs)

Accepted at New Glarus True Value Hardware at a fee.

Tires Accepted at Green County Landfill. For additional information, including fees, please call the Landfill at (608) 897-8605 or check the Village website at www.newglarusvillage.com/residents/garbage-recycling.

Used Oil Accepted during normal business hours at Stampfli Auto. Only non-contaminated oil is accepted. Cannot contain anti-freeze.

Oil Filters Used oil filters and oil absorbents are banned for disposal into landfills. Oil filters that are properly drained may be brought to the Green County Landfill at no charge or a salvage yard for recycling. Smoke Detectors Should be returned to manufacturer. These *cannot* be placed with garbage or recycling as they contain *toxic materials*.

Medications Prescription drug drop box located in the lobby at Village Hall. You may also contact Green County Health Department [<http://www.greencountyhealth.org> or 608-328-9390] for proper disposal. *Do not flush down the toilet or pour into drains.*

Paint Non-lead paint can be placed with regular garbage provided the paint is completely dry. *Can add clean cat litter to absorb paint.*

Hazardous Waste Disposal

Accepted at Green County Landfill from May 1 – October 31. For information on the specific items accepted for drop-off contact the Green County Landfill at (608) 897-8605.
