Terms and Conditions

NGLW provides for metering of water that is not discharged to the sanitary sewer system. The following rules and regulations govern the installation and use of second/deduct meters for residences and commercial establishments:

1. Application for a second/deduct meter shall be made on forms provided by NGLW. A copy of the application shall be forwarded to the NGLW Supervisor for review and approval.
2. It is the policy of NGLW that second/deduct meters shall be permanently installed and that only external hose bibs are allowed. All meters must be installed per the plumbing code at the time of installation and may require a plumbing permit from the Village of New Glarus Building Inspector.
3. The applicant agrees to pay installation, monthly, and usage fees for the second/deduct in accordance with Public Service Commission of Wisconsin Rules. Current Fees (5/1/08) \$35.00 Installation Charge + \$4.75/month meter charge (5/8" meter). It is the applicant's responsibility to contact NGLW for associated up-to-date fees.
4. NGLW is not responsible, nor can they, do plumbing beyond the curb stop for the second/deduct meter. It is the applicant's responsibility to contract with a certified plumber.
5. If abuse of a second/deduct meter is detected by a Village Official, the entire reading of the deduct meter may be disallowed by the Public Works Committee. Revocation of second/deduct meter privileges may be considered.
